Introduction

European regions are diverse — economically, ecologically and culturally. These areas are home to a wealth of ecosystems and resources, where the bioeconomy carries the promise of opportunities for rural employment and sustainable growth. This transition towards a new, bio-based regional economy requires the active involvement of a broad spectrum of stakeholders and the sustainable use of agricultural, forest and marine ecosystems. Building on this idea, BE-Rural will explore the potential of regional and local bio-based economies and support the development of bioeconomy strategies, roadmaps and business models.

Aim of the workshop

The workshop aims to enhance the capacities of researchers and businesses within the OIPs to engage in effective research & innovation (R&I) activities and cooperation. The particular objectives of the event are to deliver content on 'how to'

- (i) Find sources of inter/national R&I funding
- (ii) Identify suitable calls, requirements and reference documents (focus on Horizon Europe programme)
- (iii) Design good application and avoid common mistakes
- (iv) Start preparing your project proposal

Target participants

This Capacity Building Workshop is targeted at research institutions and research/innovation SMEs located in the five innovation regions of BE-Rural project (Vidzeme and Kurzeme in Latvia; Szczecin and Vistula Lagoons in Poland; Covasna in Romania; Stara Zagora in Bulgaria; and Strumica in North Macedonia). To participate in the workshop, participants do not need to have prior experience with international research projects.
